



St. Michael's Summer Stretch 2015 Code of Conduct

The following regulations are based on the dignity of the person, responsibility of self, respect for others and Catholic tradition. Following this Code of Conduct will promote a positive experience for all.

All participants in the event, including stretchers, chaperones, and teen leaders must read these rules carefully. Parents/guardians, stretchers, and teen leaders must sign this form and return it with their liability waiver. Both must be turned in before or on the first day of Summer Stretch.

- ◆ Stretchers will arrive each Wednesday at 8:30am and will be picked up at 3pm unless otherwise noted. Teen leaders will arrive at 8:00am each day.
- ◆ All participants will come dressed appropriately for service work (including summer stretch t-shirts, long shorts, and closed-toe shoes) with a water bottle in hand. Some days will require a bathing suit, sunscreen, and towel, as well.
- ◆ All participants will have a positive attitude and participate fully in all aspects of the summer stretch day including morning meeting, service sites, and afternoon activities.
- ◆ All stretchers and teen leaders must remain seated and use quiet voices while riding on the bus.
- ◆ No use or display of tobacco/smoking, alcohol, illicit drugs, or weapons of any kind or imitation of such will be tolerated. This includes anything that could be construed as a weapon.
- ◆ Any student involved with pulling or tampering with FIRE ALARMS will be reported to the police.
- ◆ Harassment, fighting or inappropriate behavior or inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
- ◆ Vandalism/Damage to the building, furniture, busses, or equipment will not be tolerated and any related expenses will be the responsibility of the perpetrators.
- ◆ Youth are responsible for keeping track of their property. St. Michael's is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.
- ◆ No one is allowed to leave the premises without permission.
- ◆ Only people registered, volunteering, or somehow involved in the coordination for the event will be allowed unless otherwise authorized by St. Michael's Administration.
- ◆ Youth are expected to follow the rules as established by the adult leaders.
- ◆ When conflicts arise, it is the young person's responsibility to personally resolve the conflict in an appropriate manner. Your group leader is available to mediate; however, if brought into the discussion, all parties must abide by the group leader's decision.
